VACANCY FOR CO-OPTION OF A NEW COUNCILLOR TO EXMOUTH TOWN COUNCIL IN TOWN WARD

The closing date for submissions is Tuesday, 20 June 2023 at 5pm.

We invite people from all backgrounds and experiences to put themselves forward. You don't need any experience or special qualifications but you need to be:

- British or a citizen of the Commonwealth. (You may also be eligible as a citizen of the European Union, however the criteria has changed now that the UK has left the European Union.
- At least 18 years old.
- Registered to vote in the area or have lived, worked, or owned property there for at least 12 months before an election.
