Councillors Mark Williamson and Andrew Woodward checked the bank statements against the bank reconciliation during the meeting. The discussion regarding a change of bank, due to

the administrative difficulties experienced with high street banks, was concluded with an agreement to present findings on alternatives, at the meeting in May.
